The term "**OSU Campus**" means any building or property owned or controlled by "Oklahoma State University", within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution and used by the institution in direct support of, or in a manner related to, the institution's educational purposes, including residence halls. It also includes property within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution that is owned by the institution but controlled by another person, is used by students, and supports institutional purposes (such as a food or other retail vendor). **Res.** includes those buildings designated as Residence Halls and University Apartments and **Other** is any non-Res. area on campus.

"Non-Campus Building or Property" includes any building or property owned or controlled by a student organization, such as a fraternity or sorority, recognized by the institution and any building or property (other than a branch campus) owned or controlled by an institution ... that is used in direct support of, or in relation to, the institution's educational purposes, is used by students and is not within the same reasonable contiguous geographic area of the institution. This includes Lake Carl Blackwell and research land west of the main campus.

"Public Property" is defined as all public property that is within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution, such as a sidewalk, a street, a thoroughfare, or parking facility, and is adjacent to a facility owned or controlled by the institution if the facility is used by the institution in direct support of, or in a manner related to the institution's educational purposes.
